Driving Directions to SS Jeremiah O'Brien Parking

Early Arrivals: 2:00. Ship Tour: 3:00. Meeting: 4:00.

- 1. Approach Fisherman's Wharf, probably via Bay Street.
- 2. Go north on **Taylor Street** as far as you can go, until you are about to run into the **Museé Mechanique** on Pier 45. Don't hit too many jay-walking tourists: we need their ticket money.
- 3. Turn left in front of Museé Mechanique.
- 4. Turn **right** at end of the Museé Mechanique building. If you get to the Fishermen's Chapel, you have gone too far.
- 5. Turn **right** at the end of the building. Do not go to the end of the pier.
- 6. Turn left to enter the parking building.
- 7. Look for the **SS** *Jeremiah O'Brien* parking section along the **right side** of the building. Someone will be waiting to guide you in and give you a parking pass. If no one is there, check in at the ticket booth alongside the ship. Do not park anywhere in the building except in the *J.O'B* parking lot: towaways are in force.
- 8. Go through the door in the wall to the east and report at the ticket booth, identifying yourself as a Cultural Connections member. The ship will be open for touring from **3:00 to 4:00**, with docents at key positions and white demand-sound boxes throughout the ship. Don't miss the museum in Number One 'Tween Deck and the engine room.

Note: Parking is limited. Please car pool or use public transportation if possible.

For Early Arrivals: An Additional Visit

The Maritime Museum's new exhibits in the lower level of the Hazlett Warehouse will be open and the curator who was in charge of designing and building it, Richard Everett, will be on hand to quide you in from **2:00 to 3:00**.

- 1. Leave the parking area at the SS *Jeremiah O'Brien* and walk back toward Fisherman's Wharf.
- 2. Turn right on **Jefferson Street**.
- 3. Walk west three blocks. Walk quickly and you won't be mistaken for a tourist.
- 4. Turn left into the **Maritime Museum** visitors center and exhibit. If you reach the park, you have gone too far.
